**Job Title:** Teaching Artist

**Position Type:** Part Time

### **Job responsibilities will include the following:**

The Teaching Artist (Acting, Art, or Hip Hop Dance), with direction from the Executive Director and Visual Arts Program Manager, serves as a mentor to school-age children using curriculum provided by the Foundry Center for the Arts. The Teaching Artist instructs a small group class (12-15 1st - 5th grade students) in their select artform (Acting, Art, Hip Hop Dance) for our After School Arts programs. This position also requires an individual to follow and uphold the mission of the Foundry Center for the Arts.

### **Requirements:**

- High School Diploma, Associate's or Bachelor's preferred
- Possess a valid driver's license
- Effective communication skills, both written and verbal
- Basic computer skills preferred (Email)
- Previous experience with youth in a formal setting preferred
- Agree to the Foundry's Statement of Faith and have a comfort level praying with students
- Display core values of the The Foundry Center for the Arts
- Other duties deemed necessary by the Executive Director and Visual Arts Program Manager
- Recruit students for programs
- Be able to commit to working one school year
- Follow daily curriculum schedule
